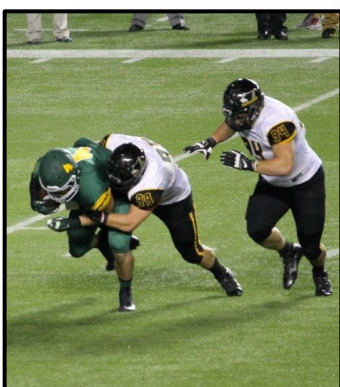

Brandon Hutchison was a big, strong and extremely athletic defensive lineman for Michigan Tech University. Brandon is truly a student of the game and can play any position on the defensive line. Brandon is a 4 time **GLIAC All-Academic** player. With his size and speed he is able to shed blocks easily and find the ball carrier immediately. Brandon's explosiveness off the line of scrimmage allowed him to meet ball carriers in the back field more times than not. Brandon is a top 2016 NFL draft prospect and can prove his intelligence along with strength will be an asset to any defensive line. Brandon's vertical jump (36) at the NFL Regional Combine in Minnesota on March 5th 2016 was the highest for his position.

2015:

Brandon started all 10 games his senior season, 3 as DE and 7 as DT. Finished the season with 38 tackles, 10 TFL, 1 PBU and 2.5 sacks. Was named **GLIAC All-Excellence** and **GLIAC All-Conference Honorable Mention**. He also won the **Iron Man Award in 2015** and set the **DT Squat record of 610**. Brandon dominated the Wayne State contest with 9 tackles and 2 TFL. He also had 6 tackles and 1.5 TFL vs Saginaw Valley State. Also added 4 tackles with 3 TFL vs Northern Michigan and 6 tackles with 1 TFL vs Lake Erie.

2014:

Brandon started all 11 games at defensive tackle. He finished the season with 36 tackles, 2 PBU, 1 sack and 4.5 TFL. Was named **GLIAC All-Academic** again. Brandon had an outstanding game vs Northern Michigan where he tallied 7 tackles with 2.5 TFL. He also had 7 tackles and 1 TFL vs Ferris State. Added 6 tackles vs Ashland.

2013:

Brandon played in 8 games starting 5 of them. He finished the season with 14 tackles and 1 TFL. He was asked to play a hybrid of DE and DT meaning he had to know all four positions of defensive line. Appeared as the 5th man and main reserve for the first five games but then started 5 games at defensive tackle to end his redshirt sophomore season. Was named to **GLIAC All-Academic** for the second year.

2012:

Brandon appeared as a reserve DE and on special teams. Named to **GLIAC All-Academic**.

BEFORE MICHIGAN TECH:

Brandon played at Northville High School. His senior year he recorded 45 tackles along with 7 sacks. Brandon was named to **All-Kensington Lakes Athletic Association** and **All-Region Team**.
