



Carrington Hanna is the definition of an athlete. Through out his career he was successful playing wide receiver, tight end, running back and quarterback. Hanna was named **NCAA D2 CoSida Academic All-American, 1<sup>st</sup> Team All- Conference Receiver** and **2<sup>nd</sup> Team All-Conference Quarterback** in his senior season. Hanna has the speed and versatility to play any position and be a dominant force offensively. Hanna's size allows him to break tackles and be a constant threat to defenses. Hanna played tight end for Team USA in 2015 and helped his team to win a IFAF Gold Medal. This explosive player has the skill set and experience to play any position in an offense and be and will be asset to any NFL team.

**2013:** Hanna was named **Pre-Season All-American Selection (WR)** and **Pre-Season NSIC Offensive Player of Year** going into 2013. Hanna played in all 11 games his senior season. He played wide receiver, running back and quarterback. He racked up 214 yards rushing, 491 receiving on 44 catches and 1085 passing on 99 completions. He finished the season with 3 receiving touchdowns and 7 passing touchdowns. Hanna's best receiving game came vs Winona State on (10/12) where he had 11 catches for 139 yards and 1 touchdown. His best game at the Quarterback position came the next week vs Concordia- St. Paul on (10/19) where he threw for 407 yards and 4 touchdowns.



**2012:** Hanna had a breakout season in first year as full time starter at wide receiver. He had 69 catches for 898 yards and 10 touchdowns. Hanna **led the NSIC in receptions per game (6.27) and ranked second in receiving touchdowns.** (10)He averaged 81.5 yards per game which was the league's fifth-best. Earned **NSIC South all-conference second team honors.** Was also named **Co-SIDA Academic All-American and All-District** with a 3.42 GPA. Hanna led USF with 40 receptions that resulted in a first down. Hanna had eight grabs, 113 yards and two touchdowns at St. Cloud State (8/30)He also pulled in a career-long 61-yard score in a win over MSU on (9/8). Hanna caught the game deciding 9 yard TD at Augustana on (10/20).

**2011:** In his first season at USF Hanna started at the quarterback position in 5 games, throwing for 785 yards and seven touchdowns. Hanna threw the long ball successfully with 3 completions over 45 yards. He also led the Cougars in total offense with 1,160 yards. His biggest game came at home against William Jewell on (10/1) when he threw for 217 yards and two touchdowns, while running for a season high 116 yards and two rushing touchdowns. Hanna finished second on the squad in rushing recording a net of 375 yards averaging 5.1 yards per carry. He also recorded 446 all-purpose.

**BEFORE SIOUX FALLS:** 2009-2010 @ **California- Pennsylvania:** Received a full scholarship to play Quarterback. Hanna redshirted the 2009 season at California- Penn. In 2010, Hanna appeared in 11 games as a reserve running back and on special teams. Was named a **PSAC Scholar-Athlete in 2010.**

**HIGHSCHOOL:** Hanna was a **three year letterman, two time all-state and all-conference selection.** He had over 4,200 yards and 54 touchdowns in his final two seasons and also passed for 1,500 yards and rushed for 1,000 as a senior. He had 30 scores as a senior. As a junior passed for 800 yards and rushed for a 1,000 while finding the end zone 23 times. Graduated top 10 in his class and an **all-academic conference honoree** all four years.
