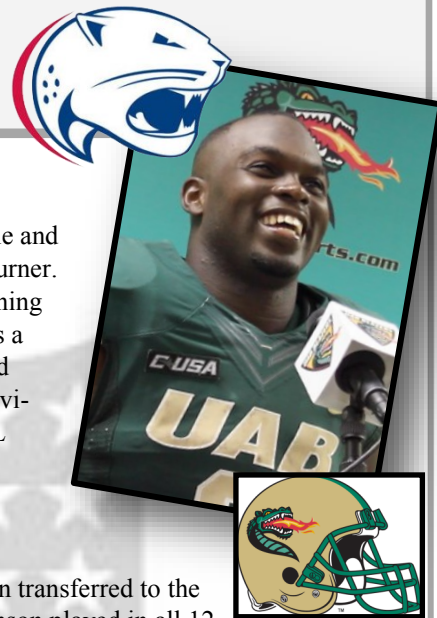


DJ Vinson – RB/WR/KR

DJ Vinson was a powerful weapon for both UAB and South Alabama. This extremely versatile and freakishly athletic player has the ability to line up as a running back, wide receiver or kick returner. Vinson played the running back position for UAB and was extremely successful with 767 rushing yards and 12 touchdowns in his career. After transferring to South Alabama, he was needed as a wide receiver and proved he can effective anywhere on the field. Vinson uses his big body and powerful running style to run over defenders if they get in his way. Vinson used his excellent vision and balance to be a huge problem for defenders. As a top draft prospect for the 2016 NFL Draft, Vinson has proved that his versatility and competitiveness are NFL caliber.



2015:

After UAB's football program was shut down, Vinson transferred to the University of South Alabama for his final season. Vinson played in all 12 games as a wide receiver in his final season. He hauled in 23 catches for 193 yards and 1 TD for the Blazers. Caught 4 passes for 22 yards in a season opening win vs Gardner-Webb on 9/5/15. Had 3 catches for 57 yards vs NC State on 9/26/15. Also had 4 catches for 28 yards in the Georgia State game on 11/21/15.

2014: This was Vinson's best year of his college career. Appeared in all 12 games at UAB and was second on the team in rushing with 670 yards and nine touchdowns on 166 attempts. Vinson caught 15 passes for 65 yards and a score as well. He ended the year third on the squad in scoring, total offense and all-purpose yards. Vinson gained 106 yards and scored in the season opening win over Troy. Also had 106 yards and five touchdowns vs Alabama A&M. Vinson set a school game record with those 5 scores. Rushed 10 times for 86 yards and a touchdown in the season ending victory at Southern Mississippi, adding three receptions for 22 yards in helping the Blazers become eligible for a postseason bowl for the first time since 2004. Also had 76 yards on 16 attempts in a win at Western Kentucky. Collected 74 yards and a touchdown in a Florida Atlantic win.

2013: Did not see any action for the Blazers.

2012: Did not see any action due to injury.

2011: Played in all 12 games for UAB and caught 11 passes for 97 yards (8.8 avg.).

Caught two touchdown passes in last two games of season vs. Southern Miss and at Florida Atlantic. Also returned 22 kickoffs for 473 yards with a 21.5 average, second-most returns among the team. Caught passes in last four games of the season. Had a season long 48 yard reception vs. Tulane. Also had season bests vs. Houston in kickoff returns with four and 99 return yards.

2010: Redshirted in his first season at UAB.

HIGHSCHOOL: Prepped at Clay-Chalkville High, where he earned three letters in football. Was named to the **Birmingham News All-North/East Offensive Team** following the 2009 season. Vinson set a school record with over 1,000 all-purpose yards in helping the Cougars to an 8-2 finish.
