Terrious Triplett is a well-rounded defensive back with smart instincts and quick feet. Triplett is able to use his size and power to make tackles most defensive backs would shy away from. Triplett had a total of 89 tackles, 3 INT's and 10 PBU in two seasons with UTM. Triplett's coverage skills and soft hands allow him to be highly effective in the secondary. This former transfer has proved he has the skill set and knowledge to play at the next level. Being a 2016 NFL draft prospect, Triplett can prove that his man to man coverage skills and hard hitting presence would be an asset to an NFL defense.

2015: Triplett played and started in 10 games as a senior leader for the Skyhawks. Finished 2nd on the team in tackles with 61 stops (32 solo), 3 tackles for loss and 1 sack. Triplett also had 1 interception, 1 fumble return and 7 passes broken up on the season. Led the team with 6 tackles at No.15 Ole Miss in the first game of the season, Had 7 stops and 1 fumble recovery in a close game vs No.1 Jacksonville State on Sept 26. Had a season high 9 tackles and 1 TFL in a win at Austin Peay on Oct 17th. Had a huge game vs Tennessee State where he tallied 5 tackles, 1 interception and a blocked field goal to help secure a win on Oct 10th. Also added 8 tackles vs Arkansas on Oct 31st.

2014: Made an immediate impact in the defensive backfield, seeing time in 11 games with two starts. Recorded 28 tackles, two interceptions, 1 tackle for loss and three pass breakups. Had an interception in back to back weeks against No. 22 Eastern Kentucky September 20th and Southeast Missouri on September 27th. Triplett tied a career high with five tackles while breaking up two pass in the win at Eastern Illinois on November 22nd. Also made five stops at No. 8 Jacksonville State on October 4th.

BEFORE UT-Martin:

Triplett transferred to UTM from Holmes Community College in Goodman, Mississippi. Tallied 61 tackles, one interception, one forced fumble, six pass breakups and three blocked kicks in 2013. Had 18 tackles (12 solo) at Mississippi Gulf Coast on September 5th 2013. Triplett began his collegiate career at Arkansas State, where he played for current Auburn head coach Gus Malzahn. Played in seven games in 2012, making six tackles as a true freshman.

High School: Triplett was a star at Ridgeway High School. He was a **First Team All-State honoree** after helping his team to a 13-1 record and a spot in the semifinals of the 2010 state playoffs. Triplett recorded 63 tackles, seven TFL and five interceptions as a senior. He also participated in the AutoZone Liberty Bowl High School All-Star Game. Also tallied 50 tackles and 22 passes defended as a junior.
