# Raiders invite West Georgia quarterback Austin Trainor to rookie minicamp

West Georgia quarterback Austin Trainor was in the right place at the right time.

He performed impressively while throwing deep balls to Central Florida standout wide receiver Breshad Perriman with New England Patriots coach Bill Belichick in attendance at the Pro Day workout in Orlando, Fla.

He did well enough that the Oakland Raiders have invited him to participate in their rookie minicamp that begins May 7.

Trainor went undrafted last year.

The 6-foot-3, 231-pounder runs the 40-yard dash in 4.99 seconds with a 29-inch vertical leap and bench pressed 225 pounds 11 times.

Trainor worked out at IMG Academy last year and was praised for his arm strength and athleticism.

Trainor began his career at Florida A&M where he was a starting quarterback before transferring to West Georgia.

Trainor played in high school at North Florida Christian in Tallahassee, Fla.

Trainor is represented by Maryland-based agent Scott Bergman.

Scouts may have been there to see Perriman, but Trainor opened some eyes as well. Among them was the Raiders [4], who according to the National Football Post [5], have invited Trainor to attend their rookie minicamp in May.

Trainor went underaft last year, which is why he can accept the invitation now. The invitation is a tryout for the team who will be looking for a camp arm behind Derek Carr [6], Matt McGloin [7] and Christian Ponder. McGloin himself went undrafted and had to try out for NFL teams. He earned a spot on the Raiders ahead of drafted fourth round QB Tyler Wilson. So, anything is possible for Trainor.

The 6-3, 231-pounder played his first two seasons of college ball at Florida A&M and later transferred to West Georgia.

As a freshman at Florida A&M, he led the Rattlers to 6-straight wins to finish the seasons as MEAC co-champions. The following season he would lose his starting job to freshman Damien Fleming four games in. Seeing no chance of starting at FAMU, he transferred to D-II West Georgia.
